Auburn Little League – Volunteer Requirement

Family Participation Program (Volunteering)

Auburn Little League families play a huge role in the success of our league. ALL is run 100% by volunteers. We cannot run a league this size (500 players/40 teams) without your help. Throughout the season, there are a variety of opportunities for everyone to participate and contribute to the success of our teams and Auburn Little League.

What is the expectation?

Auburn Little League <u>requires volunteer service from each family</u> for a minimum of **TWO (2) hours** for **T-ball and Farm A** Divisions and **SIX (6) hours** for **AA, AAA, Majors, Intermediate and Juniors** Divisions. Softball divisions will be required to complete **FOUR (4) hours**. 1-Manager, 2-Coaches, and 1-Team Parent are exempt from volunteer hours beyond their managing/coaching/parenting hours.

A volunteer services <u>deposit of \$200 is required for each family</u> (not per player), \$100 deposit for T-Ball/Farm A. If a family has multiple players, the deposit will be required for the oldest players division/team.

Volunteer checks will be collected by Managers or Team Parents when uniforms are handed out before the start of the season. <u>Players will not receive their uniforms until</u> <u>the volunteer check is provided.</u> Please make checks payable to Auburn Little League.

To fulfill the volunteer services requirement, a player's family must complete the required hours of volunteer time, no later than the completion of the Auburn Tournament of Champions (TOC). Once the required volunteer services hours have been completed, the \$200/\$100 deposit will be returned to you, or shredded, if you prefer. If the

required volunteer services hours are not completed by the deadline, your \$200/\$100 deposit check will be cashed after the end of the Auburn TOC (usually mid-June).

There's also an option to opt out of volunteer hours and pay the \$200/\$100 fee. Your purchase will go to pay teens to work various positions. If you decide not to complete the volunteer services hours and prefer to opt out, please email volunteers@auburnlittleleague.org

- Team Scorekeeper (AA/AAA/Majors/Juniors Divisions)
- Team Pitch Counter (AA/AAA/Majors/Juniors Divisions)
- Field Prep for home games
- Field Clean-up after the last game
- Snack Shack Volunteer
- BBQ/Grill for Snack Shack

- Opening Ceremonies
- League Umpire
- Picture day
- Local TOC and if hosting district TOC (Tournament of Champions)
- Practice Assistant (Registered volunteer, Live Scan and background check required-1 per team)
- 1-Team Manager, Coach (up to two per team), 1-Team Parent
