



Auburn Little League (ALL) 2022 Junior Umpire Incentive Program

This season Auburn Little League will be using a “Points System” to define which divisions, umpire positions, and pay scale that a Junior umpire will be able to do and receive. The purpose behind this system is to ensure that Auburn provides appropriately trained umpires for the respective divisions they are providing support to.
